Norma are pretentious. But don't fool yourself to believe that Norma is one of those boring and theoretical bands. Their music is warm and embracing and brings you on a journey through their musical world of kraut, ambient, electronica, noise and indie. It's all joint together by their love for landscapes and David Lynch.

Norma is also a concept striving to give the audience both a visual and musical experience.

Their goal is to go beyond the classical format of a band, and collaborate with all kinds of creative people.

Norma is about using the minimalistic sound that comes out of only having three members and still being able to challenge it and sound like a full orchestra.

Norma live is not just music. By using videoprojections (created by THE VIDIOTS), atmospherical sounds and balance between light and dark they give the audience a multidimensional experience.

This is Normas debut, but they are no newcomers in music. The members have also played in bands like Montt Mardié (Live), Torpedo and Tom Malmqvist.
